*Mr.* Joshua Tew is a graduate of The University of North Carolina at Pembroke. Mr. Tew has taught band, chorus, and general music to all age groups in private and public schools. He is currently the band and chorus director at Midway High School and also teaches private piano and wind band instrument lessons. Mr. Tew has been selected as Teacher of the Month multiple times, and was selected as the Midway High School Teacher of the Year for the 2015-2016 school year. During his tenure in the Midway District, the band and chorus programs have grown at an astronomical rate. Before becoming the full-time music teacher at Midway High School, Mr. Tew also served as the band director at Midway Middle School in a split-position role between Midway Middle School and Midway High School. During his direction of the bands in the Midway District, the marching and concert bands have received numerous superior ratings in various competitions and MPA. The Midway High School Concert Band received its first superior rating at MPA in school history under the leadership of Mr. Tew. He is a member of the National Association for

Music Education and the Southeastern District Band Directors Association. Mr. Tew also serves as the department chair of the Arts Department at Midway High School and is the chair of the Solo and Ensemble MPA for the Southeastern Band Directors Association. He also enjoys judging talent shows and marching band competitions. Outside of school, Mr. Tew enjoys animals, having a pet cat and chickens! He is also a big NASCAR fan.



*Mr.* Rodney K. Workman is the Director of Bands at Central Davidson High School in Lexington, NC and Immediate Past-President of the North Carolina Bandmasters Association. He received degrees in Music Performance and Music Education from Appalachian State University. For the past 12 years he has taught band at Central Davidson Middle and High School. While at Central Davidson Middle where his bands received only Superior Ratings in Grades II, III, IV and since coming to the High School his bands have received only Superior Ratings in Grade V, VI and Masterworks at the District MPA. Currently, he teaches 3 high school concert band classes each day, the after-school Marching Band and assists with the middle school bands in the afternoon serving more than 520 students each day.

In addition to his school work he has served on staff of UNCG Summer Music Camp, Cannon Music Camp, Mars Hill University Summer Music Camp. Most recently he has served as a conductor of the Junior Bands at UNC-G Summer Music Camp, the Cannon Music Camp Symphonic Band and is also a conductor of the "Carolina Ambassador's Honor Band" which tours the U.K., France, Switzerland, Austria, Germany and Italy giving concerts in each country during June and July. He is a regular guest clinician for All County and All District Bands having conducted more than 30 clinics in recent years in North Carolina, South Carolina and Virginia.

Mr. Workman has been the recipient of the "First Year Teacher of the Year" award while teaching in Burke County, was selected as the 2011-2012 "Teacher of the Year" at Central Davidson Middle as well as being selected as a finalist for the same award for the Davidson County School System. He was also selected to receive the "Ed Rooker Encore Award" from the American School Band Directors Association is a member of that group. In 2014 he was selected as School Band and Orchestra Magazine's "50 Directors Who Make a Difference" representing North Carolina and in the fall of 2018 was featured in the Piedmont Triad's "Youth Impact Magazine."

Mr. Workman is active in the North Carolina Bandmasters Association having served as the President, High School Auditions Host, Section Delegate for Band on the NCMEA Board, High School All State Clinic Chair and district Representative on the Concert Band MPA Committee. He currently serves as the President of the North Carolina Bandmasters Association. He is active in the Northwest District where he has served as President, and currently serves as the Middle School Audition Site Host. He is also a member of the National Band Association, the American School Band Director's Association, the Gamma Beta Phi Society, Kappa Delta Pi and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia Fraternity.
