*M*r. Britton Goodwin, a native of Kernersville, North Carolina, graduated from Hoggard High School in Wilmington and earned a Bachelor of Arts in Music Education from East Carolina University. After beginning his teaching career in Bladen County, Mr. Goodwin served as Band Director at South Columbus High School from 2006 until December of 2011. During this time, the band program grew in both quantity and quality. The marching band received numerous awards, including being named Class 1A-2A 'Grand Champion' in 2009. The concert band consistently received ratings of "Superior" at the local Strawberry Festival and also at the district Music Performance Adjudication in 2010. Mr. Goodwin was named South Columbus High School's 'Teacher of the year' during the 2010-2011 school year.

Currently, Mr. Goodwin is the Director of Bands at Scotland High School where he and his Assistant Director serve over two-hundred students. Mr. Goodwin oversees the Ninth-Grade Band, Concert Band, Symphonic Band, Jazz Ensemble, Winter Guard, and the 'Pride of Scotland County' Marching Band. In addition to winning numerous awards and 'Superior' ratings, the Marching Band has been the 'Grand Champion' at Gray's Creek High School for three years in a row, and has performed in Disney's Magic Kingdom and the Macy's Holiday Parade in Universal Studios, Florida. The Concert and Symphonic Bands have consistently received 'Superior' ratings at the district Music Performance Adjudication. The Scotland Winter Guard has successfully competed in Atlantic Indoor Association and Winter Guard International regional events in North Carolina, South Carolina, and Virginia. Mr. Goodwin has conducted All-County High School Bands in Columbus, Sampson, and Cumberland Counties.

Britton and his wife Holly, and their daughter Genevieve, reside in Laurinburg, NC.



*D*r. Jerry Markoch is currently in his 31st year of teaching and 23rd year as Director of Bands at Athens Drive High School in Raleigh, N.C. During his tenure at Athens Drive, the band program has grown to nearly 200 members and has earned significant honors, including consistent "Superior" ratings at the N.C. Concert Band Festival and numerous "Grand Champion" and "First Place" awards at local and regional marching band events. In March 2014, the Wind Ensemble performed in Carnegie Hall, NY; in 2009 and 2010, concert groups performed for the Music for All/Bands of America "National Concert Band and Percussion Ensemble Festival" in Indianapolis, IN; and in 2006, 2010 and 2014, the Wind Ensemble performed at the NCMEA Conference in Winston-Salem. The Athens Drive Band Marching Band has traveled extensively throughout the eastern United States, performing at such noted locales as Busch Gardens, Hershey Park, Washington D.C., and Walt Disney World. In November 2014, the Marching Band performed in the Philadelphia Thanksgiving Day Parade. Students in the band have received much praise for their enthusiasm, fine character, and outstanding musicianship.

Our Wind Ensemble has recently earned the honor of being named an "Honor Band of North Carolina." The group will perform at High Point University in April 2017 with guest conductor Richard Saucedo.

Dr. Markoch completed a Ph.D. in music education at Louisiana State University, a M.M. at Bowling Green State University, Ohio, and a B.M. at the University of Akron, Ohio. Prior to his graduate studies, he served three years as Band Director at Manchester High School (Akron, Ohio). Dr. Markoch has received many awards for his scholarship including a prestigious fellowship at LSU and the distinction of "Valedictorian" at the University of Akron. In 2003, he was selected by his colleagues as "Teacher of the Year" at Athens Drive High School. In 2007, he was named "Band Director of the Year" by the N.C. Central District Bandmasters Association (CDBA). In 2008, he received the "Award of Excellence" from the same organization. In Fall, 2015, Dr. Markoch was awarded the Jackson Parkhurst Award for Special Achievement in Music Education from the North Carolina Symphony.

In addition to his teaching responsibilities at Athens Drive, Dr. Markoch frequently serves as a clinician and adjudicator throughout the state. "Doc"—as he is affectionately known by his students and colleagues—is an avid golfer and resides in Fuquay-Varina with his wife, Susan, and his children, Ben and Caroline.
